Scholarship consists of an award of \$1000 to help cover tuition and course related costs.

## Criteria

- The Scholarship may be awarded to one or more students.
- Preference will be given to students in full time UCOL Te Pūkenga study.
- Open to students of all iwi.
- The applicant must have proven commitment to te reo me ona tikanga.
- The selection committee may decide to short list applicants and request them to orally present their application.
- The Committee will not comprise of any person/s who has nominated an applicant or acted as a referee for the applicant.
