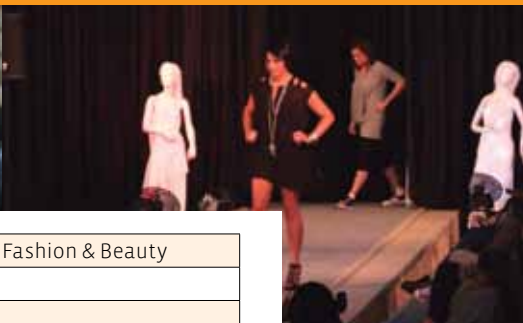


Fashion or Beauty? Learn about both at UCOL!

This very popular certificate gives a taster in fashion, catwalk, hair and beauty therapy. In fashion you will design and construct two garments to be paraded at a fashion show. You will learn “how to model on a catwalk” and what it takes to become a model. The hair component teaches the basics of healthy hair and styling. Under beauty you learn about correct skin care, waxing, eyelash and eyebrow tinting, makeup application, manicure, pedicure and customer care. During the programme you will build confidence and self awareness, and gain computing and communication skills. Plus you will also complete a First Aid Certificate, along with some numeracy and literacy unit standards.
