Criminal convictions self-declaration form (international applicants)

All references to UCOL on this form should be read as references to Te Pūkenga – New Zealand Institute of Skills and Technology, trading as UCOL.

The programme you have applied for requires UCOL to conduct a criminal convictions check. Convictions are not necessarily a barrier to programme entry, but UCOL needs to be informed about them and their nature.

Therefore, we require that you declare any criminal convictions from any country <u>and</u> complete a New Zealand Police Vetting Request and Consent Form.

In the event that an unsatisfactory police vetting result is received, your enrolment will be reviewed, and your place on the programme may be cancelled.

You are also obligated to inform UCOL, if you are the subject of any police or criminal proceedings during your programme of study. Failure to do so may result in your place on the programme being withdrawn.

Please be assured that all information provided by you, or subsequently obtained, will be treated as confidential by UCOL.
