Criteria

- The Scholarship may be awarded to one or more students.
- Preference will be given to students in full-time UCOL study.
- Open to students of all iwi.
- The applicant must have proven commitment to te reo me ona tikanga.
- The selection committee may decide to short list applicants and request them to orally present their application.
- The Commee will not comprise of any person/s who has nominated an applicant or acted as a referee for any applicant.
